Babies prefer people to objects

In newborns, crying is likely to occur most in late afternoon and early evening

Signs of distress/over
stimulation - Turning away from
stimulation
Grimacing, Yawning, Back arching
Crying

Newborns sleep 15-16 hours by 3-mothhs this has dropped to 14 hours

Babies are born to be social

Newborns can only focus 22-25cm
